 David Greathouse this day claimed 400 acres of land on account of
 settling the same in conformity to an act of Assembly for settling &
 improving the vacant land of this Commonwealth lying on both sides
 of Buffalo Creek a branch of Trade water river Beginning at a B. Walnut
 at elm & hickory running N E poles and thence at right angles
 for quantity Satisfactory proof being made to the Court they are
 of opinion that the sd David Greathouse has a right to a settlement
 of 400 acres of land to include the above location & that a certificate
 issue accordingly At Copy Test Ambrose Barbour C. C.

May 2nd 1804 David Greathouse enters 400 acres of land by
 virtue of a certificate from the County Court of Henderson in
 Henderson County on both sides of Buffalo Creek a branch of
 Trade water Beginning at a B. Walnut elm & hickory running
 N E 220 poles & at right angles for compliment to include
 his improvement Test Edm Talbot J. N. C.
