To Stull, Greathouse, Swearingen & White Descendants:

Six years ago I published “The Stulls of Millsborough,” a two volume genealogy of John Stull (d. 1749), the miller, of Hagerstown, MD with six generations of his Stull, Greathouse, Swearingen and White descendants. About 340 sets were published and about 150 are still available for sale. Originally the two-volume set sold for \$100.00 plus \$10 for postage. I will now ship single two-volume sets for \$100 postpaid.

Although the price of \$100 price may seem expensive, \$83.00 of that amount only covered each set’s printing and binding costs and the remaining \$17.00 went toward the more than \$35,000 spent out of pocket for travel to court houses, archives, libraries and cemeteries, photo copies, photography and other costs associated with the 12 years of research and production of the books. It was obviously a labor of love, not a profit making venture.

These books would make a wonderful post-holiday gift to friends or family. I am prepared to make a special offer to place the remaining books in the hands of descendants and libraries:
